Utah Arts Council KEY ISSUES

New Administration

In January 2005, Governor Jon Huntsman, Jr. appointed Margaret Hunt as the director of the Utah Arts Council. She replaced Frank McEntire who served as director from January 2003 to January 2005. The Division of Fine Arts/Arts Council became part of the newly created Department of Community & Culture.

Governor Huntsman appointed six new board members including Scott Anderson, Newell Dayley (reappointment), Lyman Hafen, Pilar Pobil, Shirley



Ririe, Cordell Taylor, and Anne Watson. We appreciate the service of our outgoing board members: Hector Ahumada, Lee Bennion, Laura Lee Bradshaw, Fred Esplin, Jerald Holyoak, and Mary Ann Lee.

Artist Services

In Fall 2004, the Utah Arts Council assembled a cross-discipline team to administer the Artist Services Program. This team surveyed Utah's

artists, researched best practices among other states, and conducted a number of focus groups of Utah artists to determine how to redesign the Utah Arts Council's Artist Grant to better serve artists. As a result of this research, in Spring 2005, the Utah Arts Council launched Project Grants for Individual Artists, offering grants of up to \$500 for emerging artists and grants of up to \$2,000 for established artists.

Long-Range Statewide Plan for Arts & Culture

In Spring 2005, the Utah Arts Council began evaluating best practices with other state art agencies. To address the increased emphasis on creating public value, the Utah Arts Council launched an ambitious statewide listening tour that included town meetings, surveys, and one-onone interviews. The public was invited to attend

the town meetings to tell us what is important to them in their communities regarding arts and cultural opportunities. The Utah Arts Council will use the results of these meetings to help develop a long-range statewide plan for arts and culture in Utah.

In 2005, listening tours were held in Cedar City, Lehi, Logan, Moab, Murray, Orem/Provo, and, West Valley City. Representatives from cities and towns in the vicinity of these meetings also attended.

Utah Arts Council PROGRAMS

DesignArts Design for Life

Julius Steubing lives with seriously-involved quadriplegic cerebral palsy. His short life has been plagued with medical emergencies. He spent a great deal of time either strapped to a special needs chair or lying on his back. As a result, his muscles were slowly atrophying despite therapeutic intervention.

When Julius was four years old, design began on the Stealth Crawler. The designers worked through various prototypes to arrive at a design that was safe, well-balanced, comfortable, easy to maneuver, and aesthetically pleasing with its curved lines and sculptural tiers. Sensitive to the often unattractive, institutional quality of durable medical equipment for people living with disabilities, the designers felt it was imperative that the Stealth Crawler be attractive.

The most successful aspects of the Stealth Crawler are seen when Julius uses it, building his body awareness in space, body control and independent mobility.

The Stealth Crawler was one of twelve design works exhibited at the Utah Arts Council's third annual **DesignArts Utah** exhibit in June 2005. The Stealth Crawler is a glowing example of how design affects every-day lives, even in the smallest of ways, for the better.

Literature Making a Difference to Kids

Verity has spent much of her young life in hospitals. It's an experience to which other kids, normal kids, can't really relate. She can, however, identify with other transplant recipients at the National Foundation of Utah's Transplant Kamp.

With other "Kampers", Verity took part in a writing workshop with poet Susan Sample, funded through the Utah Arts Council with National Endowment for the Arts Challenge America funds. Susan taught the young patients how to express themselves through poetry.

These children are chronically ill and live in uncertainty. Even after they receive their transplant, "they are not immediately cured," Susan said, "and must take anti-rejection drugs for the rest of their lives. Their bodies are constantly checked and monitored, but their voices don't get attention."

The experience has certainly helped Verity.

"Here you can say personal things about your transplant and you don't get weird looks," she said. An excerpt from one of her poems:

Yes, everyone has a scar. But mine is mine. And I am proud of it.



Arts Education

New Ideas through the Arts, One Child at a Time

Dancer Monica Gomez Rogerson uses her arts education residencies in schools to teach the dances, stories and songs of Mexico in both Spanish and English. Her residencies consistently get outstanding reviews from parents, teachers and students.

Student comments particularly show the power of the arts in schools to expand developing minds, bridge cultural gaps, instill pride in achievement and generate excitement about new ideas. At the end of one residency at a mostly-Caucasian school, Monica's students gave the following responses to their experience. (Spelling is unchanged.)

"don't be nerbous. Even thowe I danced with boys the first time in my life, it was okay with me."

"I learned that Spanish is more important than I thot."

"Mexico is a state of bravery and pride."

"I thought that I couldn't ever dance infront of the audience without messing up and I didn't!"

"I learned that not all art is drawing."

"We learned about Mexico. I would like to learn more about where my great, great grandma came from and learn about Italian dancing."

"I learned that Mexican dancing represents something important to each Mexican region and each region has a different style of dancing."

"That Mexican people celebrate old people and give them respect."

"I learned that learning different cultures can be interesting and fun."

"I learned that Mexicans used instruments hundreds of years ago. I learned that Mexicans used the guitar, violin, drums and many other instruments."

"That Mixican dancing is very wild unlike ballet."

"I noticed that our feelings about one another changed. We did not think of them as a boy, we thought of them as a friend."

The arts build empathy, reasoning and community. One child, after a rural residency with Salvadore Reyes, exclaimed, "You know, I ain't never met no Mexican before and I LIKED 'im."

Community Development

Change Leader: Changing Lives

As a child, Lucille Hunt made do with toys she made herself out of weeds, flowers, rocks, sticks, or (in winter in their Hogan) her grandmother's scarf. She relied on her own creativity and imagination. Today, Hunt is still learning and creating, only in a different way. As a recently certified Change Leader in the Utah Arts Council's leadership development course, Hunt is making a difference in her community of Blanding, Utah.

When she was invited to represent her geographic area in the program, Hunt was respectfully tentative. Her understanding of change was limited to her cultural views and experience as a storyteller artist. The focus of this training was her own personal change and growth.

Hunt has since become involved in many changes in the arts community in Blanding. She credits the Change Leader program with giving her valuable tools to lead. "In all of the organizations I've been part of I have always been the silent gatherer of information only," she recalls. "I merely did what I was told to do even though at times I wanted to do more than just be a member. Then after participating in the Change Leader Program I started to speak out, make suggestions, and oppose with my disagreements. I would feel myself blushing. I was surprised to have people listen to me. Often they would come back to me asking what I thought about the idea or asking for my approval. Feeling valued for my opinions, comments, suggestions and disagreements has empowered me to speak up without fear. I don't hesitate anymore to ask questions or to make a comment."

A year into the Change Leader Program, Hunt was asked to represent the Navajo Nation on the organizing committee for Nations of the Native

West, an organization developing a living heritage center in Blanding. "I am excited about the project and I know it will help bring the diverse heritage cultures of the four corners region together. The people will regain the pride of their heritage and share it with the world."

Many of the Change Leader Program participants have seen similar personal growth during their eighteen months of training. Ellen Aguilar from the Arts Council of Magna notes, "Change Leader has done just what it implies. It changed me and hopefully has made me a better leader." The curriculum of the training focuses on the person as a leader of change while creating a mentoring and support network for arts administrators.

The Change Leader Program, made possible through the National Endowment for the Arts Challenge America program, serves Utah's arts organizations with continuing education to raise the professional level of Utah's arts administrators, and a support network to increase the strength of the arts on a community level.

Folk Arts

As a young girl, Rosina Martinez learned from her parents the old style of songs and dance tunes that has nearly been forgotten, even in their native New Mexico. Their family brought these traditional songs with them to Utah in the early 20th Century when they moved here for the greater employment opportunities.

Rosina made this music her living.

She has received apprenticeship grants to teach, has performed at Mondays in the Park concerts, and in early 2005 received an Ethnic Arts Grant to produce a recording of traditional New Mexican music.

Recently the organizers of the Festival Internacional de Culturas in Chihuahua, Mexico heard Rosina's recording and invited her to perform an eleven-day tour of northern Mexico. An investment of \$500 from the Utah Arts Council has leveraged more performing opportunities and generated international recognition for a resident artist of Utah.

Public Art National Recognition

One of Utah's newest state public art installations is receiving national and international recognition. Americans for the Arts has named *Sun Dagger* by Robert Perless an important innovative project in American public art in 2005. The Americans for the Arts Public Art Network selected forty-eight public art projects from over 150 projects nationwide. Americans for the Arts featured these works, including *Sun Dagger*, at their June 2005 national conference.

Artist Robert Perless proposed *Sun Dagger* for the western plaza of the Wasatch Campus of Utah Valley State College in response to a national call for site-specific art. *Sun Dagger* is a functional celestial observatory. It works as both a noon transit and regular sundial, and as a seasonal calendar, marking the winter and summer solstices and the vernal and autumnal equinoxes. Perless's work offers a contemporary interpretation and observation of celestial mechanics, at the same time referencing the ancient inhabitants of the land.


Visual Arts Making a Difference to Individuals

Last spring, visual artist Madison N. Smith received both a Visual Artist Fellowship award and a juror's award in the Statewide Annual Visual Arts Competition. It made a big difference to him, as he stated: "the financial support attached to both awards couldn't have come at a better time. It allowed me to focus on painting for the better part of the year without stressing about finances and having to come up with work on the side to support my art and my family. I realize that the fellowship is quite competitive and I feel very grateful to be a recipient."

Smith received his BFA in painting and drawing from Brigham Young University, where he concentrated on technique, and his MFA in painting from the San Francisco Art Institute, which taught him to communicate the subject matter of his works more effectively. "I'm drawn to the sense of nostalgia that certain objects, colors and patterns carry, triggering feelings and memories that have often changed over time. These separate images carry meaning in and of themselves, but when they are placed together they each become threads of a larger personal tapestry."

The juror for the 2005 fellowship competition, Angela Ellsworth (an artist, teacher and performer in Los Angeles), said, "I selected Madison Smith because he conveyed a personal and cultural connection to his work as it relates to nature and systems of control. He is committed to the history and memory of objects. Memory is purely subjective unless communicated to make broader connections."

Smith benefited greatly from the publicity and exposure he received as a recipient of both the fellowship and Statewide Annual juror's awards. They have given him the encouragement to continue painting, and to apply for shows, grants, teaching positions and gallery representation. His benefit will in turn reward many people with his paintings and creativity.
