These three projects combined will provide residents and visitors with better access for our constituents to valuable information and create efficiencies within our department.

Throughout history and the world, museums have served as one of the most vital institutions for the preservation and interpretation of cultural traditions. This statement also applies to the 265 museums in Utah that are a major force for the preservation and interpretation of Utah's heritage. Museums exist in all of the counties in the state. Together, the items in their collections number into the millions, and represent every facet of Utah's varied heritage.

Annually, more than six million visitors to Utah's museums learn about and gain a greater appreciation for the culture and history of Utah. Many of these visitors are tourists, others are school children, and quite a few are families enjoying a learning experience together. Utah's heritage, culture, and social environment would be much the poorer without its museums, their collections, exhibitions, and other public programs.

Within the larger and more important context of their roles as agents for heritage preservation and interpretation, Utah's museums perform critical public services:

- Museums are vital institutions of public education. They provide a valuable educational resource to schoolchildren through exhibit tours, outreach programs, and other activities.

Museums are full of treasures and if you visit a museum, you will discover first-hand the artistic, historical, and scientific wonders of the world.

MESSAGE FROM THE DIRECTOR UTAH OFFICE OF MUSEUM SERVICES

Did you visit a Utah museum last year? If you did, you were among the six million visitors served by the museum community. Museums provide a wealth of cultural and educational opportunities for residents and visitors alike, and they serve as the guardians of Utah's natural, cultural, and artistic heritage.

There are more than 265 museums in Utah, including history, art, natural science, children's museums, zoos, and botanical gardens. Utah's museums care for millions of objects. These fascinating objects provide critically important links to the past and help us better understand ourselves and the world in which we live. Museums are also the state's greatest educational resource outside public education. More than half a million Utah school children in over 10,000 school groups visit Utah museums as part of their formal education each year.

In order to re-evaluate the needs of our museums, the Office of Museum Services partnered with the Utah Museums Association and the International Daughters of Utah Pioneers to develop a survey of museum needs. One result of the survey shows that preserving collections is critical and urgent. To address this need, a preservation initiative has been launched. This initiative will provide both financial resources and expanded technical assistance to Utah museums to ensure that museum collections are preserved for future generations.

The Office of Museum Services will continue to assess the needs of the Utah museum community in order to fulfill our role. We are committed to developing and conducting programs that provide technical assistance to museums and that promote Utah museums.

The Office of Museum Services also expresses our appreciation to the Utah Legislature for appropriating \$345,000 one-time funding for museum grants in addition to our ongoing grant funds. Continued financial support will help our museums reach a higher level of performance and help them succeed in the essential role they play in our state.



Advancing the Arts

SUMMARY OF KEY ISSUES

Fiscal year 2007 was an exciting and eventful time for the Division of Arts and Museums. We sponsored several projects that brought economic growth and improved quality of life to communities throughout the state of Utah.

During the 2006 legislative session, \$100,000 was appropriated for the conservation of artwork from the State Fine Art Collection. This past year, 27 pieces were conserved by the Western Center for the Conservation of Fine Art in Colorado. Here, each painting was cleaned, repaired, and re-framed, or in some cases, the frames were restored as well. After many years of storage, these historically significant works can once again be viewed and appreciated by the public.

Utah's fine arts received another boost this year. The National Endowment for the Arts awarded funding for an American Masterpieces project. With this grant, the Utah Arts Council developed an exhibition of giclée copies of historic paintings by Utah Masters from the State Fine Art Collection for rural and underserved communities. A print catalog was also produced, along with an accompanying illustrated children's book about the Utah Arts Council's founder, Alice Merrill Horne.

Additionally, in response to our Listening Tour Initiative that started last year, we revived our statewide annual arts conference. The first annual Mountain West Conference on the Arts was held on May 10-11, 2007, at the Utah Cultural Celebration Center in West Valley City. Over 300 people participated in the conference and over 500 attended the Governor's Leadership in the Arts Awards Luncheon. We were fortunate to have First Lady Mary Kaye Huntsman present the Governor's Awards and Gregorio Luke, Director of the Los Angeles Museum of Latin American Arts, as our keynote speaker.

We are grateful for the support the Utah State Legislature gave us for the creative communities and digitization initiatives.



In 2007, as part of the digitization initiative bill passed by the legislature, the Division of Arts and Museums received approval from the Department of Community and Culture IT Council to fund three projects. These projects included a statewide events calendar, a constituent relationship management system, and a collections management system.

The statewide events calendar, called NowPlayingUtah.com will be launched in April 2008 and includes a partnership between the Zoo, Arts, and Parks of Salt Lake County and the Salt Lake Conventions and Visitors Bureau. The listing of events on the online calendar will be free to all arts and culture organizations, artists, performers, and events presenters. NowPlayingUtah.com will provide visitors and citizens of Utah a one-stop-shop to view all events that are taking place in any geographical region of Utah. This site promises to raise the visibility and exposure of all arts and culture-related organizations and individuals.

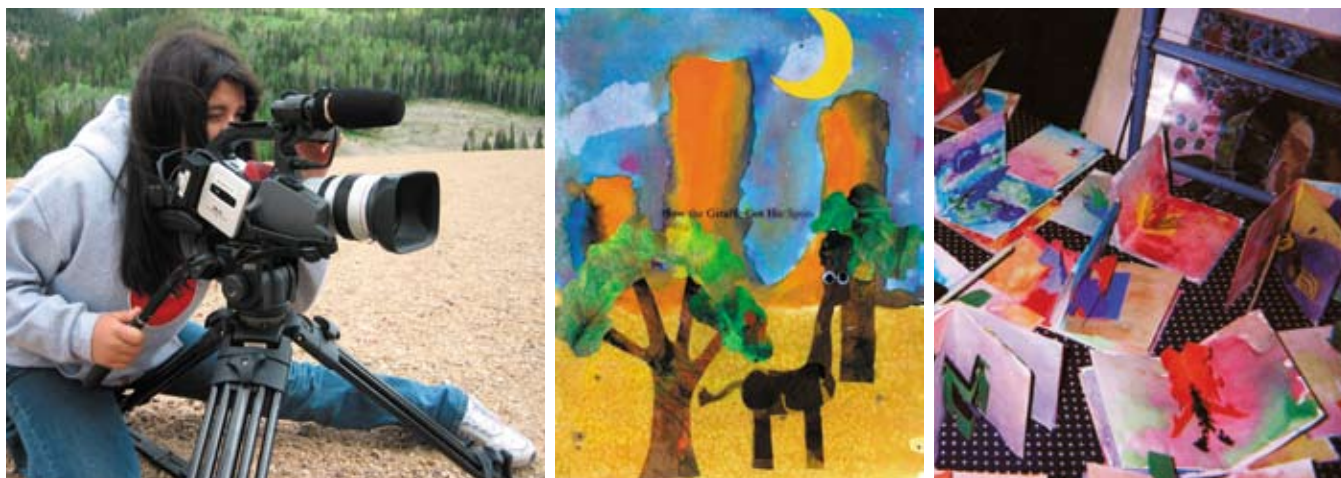
The constituent relationship management system will consolidate five separate databases into one, eliminating many manual processes, thereby creating greater efficiencies and cost savings. The initial implementation has been completed and the data cleansing and migration has concluded.

In collaboration with the Division of State History and other partners of the Mountain West Digital Libraries Consortium, the digitization of the Division of Arts and Museums collections is taking place and the resulting information will be available to the public by the end of FY08. Much of the information now residing within disparate databases will be migrated into one common database during the next several months.

The grants management system project is underway and will result in all of the funding opportunities offered by Division of Arts and Museums being available for completion and submission online. The public launch date will be determined in the near future.

Arts Education



“A Great Nation Deserves Great Art” is the quote we see most often when describing the essence of the National Endowment for the Arts. In sharing that belief, the National Endowment for the Arts asks state arts agencies to provide their children, teens, and adults with access to arts learning.

The Utah Arts Council is proud of its record of providing access to arts learning opportunities through its grants and programs; however, the Utah Arts Council believes the full arts education experience is a reciprocal process. The communities and schools who request grants and invite Utah Arts Council artists into their settings clearly demonstrate that the creative impulse resides not just in cities but in small towns and isolated communities as well.

In Fiscal Year 2007, the Utah Arts Council celebrated small schools in rural communities who gave us “access” to the joy generated by their students’ participation in arts education projects. Highlights from these schools include:

- Manila Elementary and Flaming Gorge Elementary students in Daggett County made music, danced and told stories with Roz Newmark and Mary Johnston-Coursey. The artists also performed a piece called “Ripple Tales,” to involve the community in the students’ learning process.
- K-6 students at South Summit Elementary School in Kamas, under the direction of Paul Jakubowski, painted a beautiful mural in their library and shared their

work with area mayors, school board members, parents, and legislators.

- South Rich Elementary School in Rich County, invited Dolores Perez who taught all the kids how to make beautiful Mexican paper flowers. “Yes,” one of the teachers told us, “she [Perez] even had the boys making flowers, bunches of them. Many of them made flowers for their mothers.” One boy said, “This is the first time I made something for my mom that she really, really liked.”
- Elementary and middle school Hispanic students in Tooele County participated in after school programs where they painted with Ruby Chacon, danced with Salvadore Reyes and Monica Gomez Rogerson, and created media projects with John Schaefer. The on-site coordinator said, “One of the girls in the media project really nailed a 30 second video. She captured her own respectful relationship with the school maintenance man in a chance encounter at school.”

Through our continued access and the provision of financial assistance to Utah’s small town and rural county schools, we are thankfully able to ensure that joyful art making and learning is alive and well throughout all of Utah.

Community Development



What does it mean to be a creative community in Utah? This year the recipients of the Creative Communities Grants explored this question and implemented the first funded community projects. The grant program specified

that projects should build on community assets and look for the intersections within a community such as the arts, business, tourism, history, and physical assets, such as parks. Another requirement was that the project have measurable economic outcomes in order to emphasize the role the arts play in a vital economic environment. What resulted was the buy-in of community entities as partners in planning and implementation, as well as the subsequent spread of the economic and social benefits from the program throughout the whole of the community.

Projects that emerged from the creative communities program ranged from the development of arts districts to stage renovations to murals to festivals. This year nine projects were funded around the state, including: St. George, Moab, Gunnison, Torrey, Brigham City, Helper, Logan, and Provo. One of the most notable creative endeavors that the creative communities initiative funded was the mosaic dragon in Gunnison. This 218-foot dragon was created by volunteers with the help of two local Utah artists. Using pieces of glass and mosaic tile, this group installed the mural under an overpass on a local river pathway. And adding to the effect, when trucks and cars pass overhead the sound that emerges is much like the dragon's roar.

Thanks to their Creative Communities project, Gunnison has already noticed a renewed energy within the community as well as tourist interest in the dragon. The local leadership is not only learning what it means to be a creative community but how the arts contribute to civic engagement that in turn extends to community problem solving.

Design Arts

The design arts program is dedicated to the promotion of excellence in the diverse fields of design in Utah. The program strives to help the citizens of Utah see, experience, use, and value the art of design that surrounds us daily.

The design arts are defined but not limited to architecture, landscape architecture, community design, environmental design (interior, lighting, etc.) product design (fashion, furniture, transportation, electronics, etc.) and industrial design.

Annually, the design arts program coordinates and sponsors a juried exhibition of Utah designers in a wide variety of fields. In 2007, influential designer and educator, Tucker Viemeister, reviewed submissions by twenty-one Utah designers. This review and exhibition provided opportunities for Utah's designers to have their work viewed by professionals in the field and to exhibit their work in venues outside the usual fields of design. This exhibition exposes Utahns to the talent

of Utah designers and demonstrates the contributions these individuals make to our quality of life and economy.

During fiscal year 2007, the design arts program spent \$19,242 of combined state and National Endowment for the Arts funding on exhibitions, community projects, and outreach.

Folk Arts



One of the year's highlights was an invitation for Utah Navajo basket weavers Mary Holiday Black, her daughters Sally and Lorraine, and her 14-year-old granddaughter Kayla, to participate in the 40th annual Smithsonian Folklife Festival on the Mall in Washington, D.C.

The Black family was featured as part of "Carriers of Culture: Living Basket Traditions," a program that brought together 75 of the nation's

best Native American weavers from across the country. Two weeks of discussions, demonstrations, and hands-on activities focused on the challenges and triumphs native weavers face in keeping ancient artistry and traditions alive.

Thousands of visitors watched and asked questions as the Blacks wove baskets from the large bundle of sumac they shipped to Washington. The artists also participated in many onstage interviews discussing topics such as the challenges of limited access to dwindling natural resources, the role of baskets in ceremonial and community life, and the

importance of marketing finished products.

The Blacks were enthusiastically received by festival visitors who were charmed to meet Navajos from Monument Valley, a place many knew only from television commercials. Easterners were intrigued to be able to interact with artists from remote reservation lands, and visibly delighted to meet several generations from one family — a grandmother, daughters, and a granddaughter — dedicated to maintaining their heritage by creating beautiful traditional art using just the plants growing in their desert surroundings. The Washington Post even featured the Black family in a video piece produced for their website.

The Utah portion of Monument Valley is often described as the center of contemporary Navajo basketry activity and master weaver Mary Holiday Black is recognized for revitalizing this art form among the Navajos. She received a Utah Governor's Folk Arts Award in 1993 and subsequently a prestigious National Heritage Fellowship from the National Endowment for the Arts in 1995. Today Mary Holiday Black's extended family and her Monument Valley neighbors form the core practitioners of this ancient art form that significantly contributes to both the cultural and economic vitality of their community.

Literary Arts

Fiscal Year 2007 was our second year of participation in Poetry Out Loud, a national poetry recitation contest, sponsored by the National Endowment for the Arts and the Poetry Foundation. Our state competition involved 24 Utah high schools, with 12 students competing at our state championship at Westminster College on March 9, 2007. After three rounds of competition, Amanda Fujiki, a senior at Meridian School in Provo, was named Utah State Champion. At the National Finals in Washington, DC, later that spring, Fujiki won one of 12 spots in the championship round of competition. Fujiki is now a freshman at Brigham Young University. Since her participation in the program and to her delight, she has been invited to recite poems at the Mountain West Conference on the Arts and to participate in poetry celebrations around the state.

Poetry Out Loud provides an important opportunity for Utah's high school teachers and students to incorporate poetry into the regular English curriculum and generate excitement about literature. It is a goal of the Utah Arts Council to encourage as many Utah high schools to participate as possible. This year, West High and Judge Memorial, both in Salt Lake City, had school-wide competitions that involved almost all of the English classes, and the school championships were conducted in front of the whole student body. This level of commitment after two years of the program is inspirational. As this program continues, we look to other Utah schools to participate, so that we may report an ever increasing number of similar school and Utah State Champion success stories.

Public Art



The public art program commissions artists from Utah and around the nation to create site-specific art in and around the public spaces of state facilities throughout Utah. This art, created in collaboration with the community and the staff of the facility for which it is being created, enhances and helps build healthy and beautiful communities in Utah. These site specific artworks, commissioned by the Utah Arts Council

and chosen by selection committees, can take the form of architecturally incorporated elements, landscape design, glass, textile, painting and/ or sculpture. The program is working to build and add to the quality public art collection belonging to the citizens of Utah. During fiscal year 2007, the public art program spent \$426,564 on artist commissions and \$15,536 on maintenance and conservation of Utah's public art collection.

Visual Arts



In 2006, the Utah Arts Council received funding from the National Endowment for the Arts and the Western

States Arts Federation (WESTAF) to undertake a project documenting the early works of art significant to Utah's history. The project became the Early Utah Masterpieces collection.

This project included an exhibition of 26 giclée reproductions of the first paintings purchased for the state in 1899. An exhibition catalogue was published to accompany the exhibition, and featured the exhibition artwork, artist biographies, and a profile of Alice Merrill Horne, founder of what is now the Utah Arts Council. Additionally, a children's

booklet, based on the life of Alice Merrill Horne was written by Lola Beatlebrox with original illustrations by Anita Crane. Lesson plans for teachers and self guided tour information are available online through the Utah Arts Council website.

Created with the intention to inform viewers of the importance and value of the Alice Art Collection and State Fine Art Collection, this project highlights the historical significance of the early painters, and gives a view of life and culture in Utah during the last century. The educational materials will enhance the viewers' experience and help teachers prepare students to learn how to interact with the paintings. This exhibition will move throughout the state, displaying its historic images as a new show available through the Utah Arts Council's Traveling Exhibition Program.

HIGHLIGHTS

A survey of Utah museums was developed in partnership with the Utah Museums Association and the International Society of the Daughters of Utah Pioneers. The goal of the survey was to assess the needs of Utah museums and was administered by the firm of Dan Jones & Associates to ensure a professional and accurate result. There was a 60% response from museums and the results of the survey reflect a healthy museum community, but one that has a great many needs, especially in the area of collection management. Based on this need, the Office of Museum Services will be instituting a preservation initiative to aid in conserving and preserving the collections in Utah's museums.

In support of this initiative, Ronald Sheetz, a wood conservator, presented a series of workshops on how to care for wooden objects and structures. Ron was a conservator with the National Park Service for twenty years, working on everything from the restoration of Abraham Lincoln's home in Illinois to preserving totem poles in Alaska. Workshops were held in Helper, Fillmore, and Salt Lake City and were co-sponsored by the Division of History, with funding from the Utah Humanities Council.

The Utah Office of Museum Services and the Utah State Board of Education partnered on a summer Museum Treasure Hunt for the second year. Utah elementary school age children were invited to celebrate 2006 as the Year of the Museum. More than 490 elementary schools received a brochure including 15 treasure hunt questions.

ACCOMPLISHMENTS

The Office of Museum Services collaborated with the Utah Museums Association and the Daughters of Utah Pioneers on a project entitled: "Celebrate Your Museum" which was held on September 15. Museums offered free or a reduced rate admission and many museums planned special activities for children and adults who attended.

A workshop entitled, Preserving Museum Collections: Tricking Father Time was presented Moab, Delta, Hyrum, Castledale, Lehi, and Taylorsville. The workshop covered the basics on record keeping, proper storage, and exhibition practices. A manual presenting the information in greater detail was distributed to each participant.

The Office of Museum Services sponsored a workshop for state museum associations at the Western Museums Association Annual Conference held in Boise, Idaho.

OFFICE OF MUSEUM SERVICES GRANTS FY 2006-2007

The Utah State Legislature appropriated an additional \$345,000 in one-time funding for museum grants. As a result, grants totaling \$420,414 were awarded to 100 museums during FY 2007, including 74 Project Support Grants and 26 Development Grants. In addition, a \$10,000 grant was awarded to the Utah Museums Association to help support its Annual Conference in Cedar City and scholarships totaling \$14,500 were approved for 35 museum volunteers and staff to attend the conference. Marketing grants totaling \$51,170 were given to 11 groups containing 67 museums to produce informational brochures.
