

Collaborative Arts Education Project Blueprint

CAEP is an evolving, experimental model for UAM/AE. The old model of a 2-week residency in one school or organization based on a successful grant application offered no evidence that ensured an increased commitment to arts education within any school/community. The CAEP model rests on *collaboration and partnerships* with the UAM/AE office. In addition, CAEP involves collaborations in a community by bringing teaching artists, educators, arts/cultural organizations, and any community assets/resources such as social service agencies, parks and recreation, hospitals, senior centers, correctional facilities, community centers and libraries together to plan, build, implement, evaluate, and assess arts learning and community engagement activities. Learners may be age specific, grade specific, multi-generational, educators, non-profit staff, parents, etc. CAEP is not a UA&M/AE sponsorship.
